Warangal, known for its fast modernization and rich history, is currently facing an issue that is becoming more serious and endangering the health of its youngest citizens. Schools throughout the city are being criticized for ignoring physical education, a practice that is causing childhood obesity and associated health problems to alarmingly increase. Warangal's academic environment has undergone a significant change in recent years.

Due to the growing focus on standardized testing and academic achievement, many schools have cut back on the amount of time allotted for physical education. Children now have fewer opportunities to exercise during the school day as a result of this change, which health experts caution could have disastrous repercussions.

The figures are alarming, Children in warangal are gaining weight at an

unprecedented rate, which is contributing to a number of adult-typical health problems like diabetes, high blood pressure, and joint problems. In addition to endangering the children's present health, this trend lays the groundwork for potential long-term health issues that may last into adulthood. Criticizing schools for putting academic success ahead of children's overall development, parents and health advocates are speaking out against this alarming trend.

According to Warangal based senior paediatrician said this year i have seen school children steadily increasing their weight due to longer sitting time using mobile phones, no physical activity after school hours. Education is not just about books and exams. It's about raising wellrounded people. Ignoring exercise is a serious error that jeopardizes our kid's health and future.

Facing Insufficient Qualified Faculty!

There are unquestionably many intermediate colleges in Warangal, which is known for its educational advancement and is intended to guide students toward academic success. The lack of un-qualified faculty at many prestigious colleges, however, is a fundamental problem that is quietly affecting the basis of student education. Some intermediate colleges that have earned a reputation for their academic performance in the past are now being criticized for their failure to hire faculty with the necessary qualifications.

It is concerning for both parents and students that a profession that establishes the foundation of education has witnessed a noticeable shortage of qualified teachers

needed to mentor students during their academic years. A large number of these colleges employ faculty who lack the specific training or expertise required for thorough intermediate education. In addition to placing a pressure on the current staff, the lack of qualified tutors has a significant effect on the teaching process and may result in gaps in students' academic performance.

Regrettably, these gaps show up clearly on board exams. Parents are beginning to doubt whether educational institutions are capable of providing required education and preparing their children for competitive exams due to the over-pressure by inexperienced faculty.

THE FISH FAMILY AND THE OF STAYING TOGETHER Author: N Ankitha Mehar,


